Dear Parents,

I am writing to let you know about an opportunity that is being offered to year 12 students.

The students are reaching that age when they are beginning to learn to drive, booking lessons and preparing for tests. This is a very exciting time and is a key step towards independence. However, statistically, the 17-21 age bracket is the most likely to be involved in accidents. The Emmbrook Sixth Form feel that part of our enrichment programme should cover these kinds of topics.

With this in mind, on Monday 18th November we will be taking all year 12 students to the Anvil in Basingstoke for a course aimed at young drivers.

The course is being run by the 'safer drivers' initiative and will feature a 90 min production about being a 'young driver' and all the responsibilities that come with this.

The course is funded by Thames Valley Police, who also subsidises the travel costs. This leaves a small fee (£1) to be paid by each student.

The coach will leave school at 12pm, to arrive at the Anvil for a 1pm start. Students will be picked up at approximately 2.30pm and returned to school for approximately 3.15pm.

Please complete a medical form, which is attached to the email I sent with this letter. This form needs to be printed and signed in order for students to be able to accompany the course and return to the finance office (with £1) by Friday 8th November.
