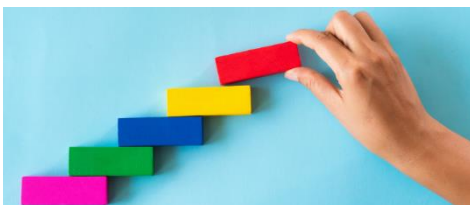
In addition to year 13, our year 12 Criminology and Further Maths students will receive their timetables next week.
