Identification of Sixth Form Students – lanyards MUST be worn

In response to safeguarding concerns which have been raised around the identification of Sixth Form students onsite, from Monday we are having a 'reset' around our expectations with lanyards. Therefore, from Monday, all Sixth Form students will need to have their badge in order to gain access to the site. They will be expected to wear their badges in a manner which makes identification possible, this should be worn around the neck.

Any student who is not wearing their lanyard on Monday, will be issued with a temporary badge but could be denied entry to the site from Tuesday.

This measure is designed to keep everyone on our site safe and we thank you for your support with this matter.
