Although formal lessons may be finishing, please remember that **tutors and subject teachers remain available to support students throughout the examination period**.

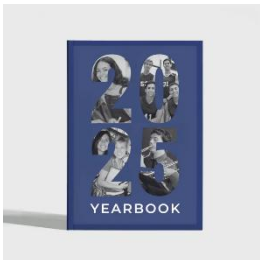
We strongly encourage students to continue seeking help, attending revision sessions where available, and making full use of the support on offer.
