



Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to you with an update on the year 11 students and the build up to their summer exams.

The students completed their WAVE2 core subject exams at the beginning of this term and they have all received their grade summary sheets. Before the Easter break, every student will receive a 'core pack' showing a detailed breakdown of how they performed in the WAVE2 exams. These documents are incredibly detailed and should provide each student with a clear and precise summary as to what to prioritize next.

The students are currently taking their non-core PPE2 exams. The results of these and feedback about the papers will be given after the Easter break. This information will also prove very useful in prioritizing final preparation and revision for the finals. Once the PPE2 exams are over, all subjects will be using the final few weeks to get the students 'exam ready'. There are already revision sessions running for core subjects after school each week.

We are offering some Easter revision classes in some subjects and I have attached a schedule to page 2 of this letter. Not every subject is able to offer Easter classes, but where the school can provide sessions, we are. Students do not have to wear uniform for these sessions and should come to school ready with the necessary equipment. Unfortunately the canteen will not be open, so students should arrive with enough food and drink to see them through.

After the Easter break, I will be writing to all parents/carers again to outline the final information for the summer exam season. This will include the statutory information from JCQ, school specific information as well as key dates. As always, we care greatly about the well-being of our students. I understand that the next few weeks could provide pressure points where students feel worry or anxiety. The work being carried out by tutors, Mr Tichband and Mrs Fyfe has been designed to increase resilience and equip students with the necessary skills and tools to cope with the stresses and strains of the next 3 months. We feel almost all of our students are 'exam ready'. However, if you do have concerns, please do not hesitate to contact your child's tutor or Mr Tichband.
