Dear Parents and Carers,

Remote Learning – Tuesday 19th July

The rapidly rising temperatures this morning have only confirmed to me that the vast majority of our classrooms and indoor spaces are utterly intolerable in these levels of heat. I believe this goes well beyond discomfort and may harm the well-being of students and staff. The forecast is for even higher temperatures tomorrow, furthermore buildings that began today warmer than the outside will not cool overnight, so the situation will certainly worsen.

As a result, and with sincere regret, the final day of term will move to remote learning.

Work will be set via Teams (in the same way that we did for students who were self-isolating during the pandemic). By doing this rather than live lessons, students can study at a time and in a location at home that is as comfortable as possible.

The planned final assembly of the year will be broadcast live over Teams between 8.30 and 9am. Students should have an invitation to attend via Teams. This should be early enough that it will still be a relatively cool time of the day.

I am sorry for any inconvenience or disruption that this causes.
