

Sixth Form Dress Code Policy

As a Sixth Form student, you have the privilege of being able to choose what to wear to school but you should dress in a suitable manner for a school environment. The Sixth Form Leadership Team consulted with the SLT for the Emmbrook School and agreed on a 'smart casual' dress code for the school Sixth Form. This includes:

- Polo shirt/shirt/blouse for everyone; these can be long or short sleeved and should be modest. Please see below for tops that students cannot wear. If in doubt check the day before if you are unsure.
- Jumper or cardigan can be worn
- Trousers (can include smart jeans no rips), ³/₄ length trousers, skirts or dresses. Smart chino shorts in the appropriate weather
- T-shirts can be worn with no inappropriate slogans (check the day before if you are not sure!)
- Smart flat shoes or ankle boots. Clean trainers are acceptable
- Leggings may be worn in place of tights (e.g. with a dress or long tunic top), but must not be worn in place of trousers.
- When taking part in school public events (Open Evenings, parent tours, parents' evenings, press opportunities, year book photos etc.) students are to wear business casual dress (ask if you are unsure); jeans are not permitted.
- ID cards should be worn and clearly visible.

It has been agreed that the following do not represent The Emmbrook School Sixth Form and are not allowed:

- Gym wear
- Tracksuits (and tracksuit shorts)
- Crop tops, vest tops, low cut tops
- Jeans with rips or tears in
- Flip flops and sliders
- Hoodies (leavers hoodies are appropriate at the end of year 13)

Consequence

Students will be asked to remove any items which are not deemed to be acceptable dress; where this is not possible students will be sent to the Head of Sixth Form who will send them home to change. If possible, they will then be expected to return to the school for the remainder of the school day.
