



The Emmbrook School Sixth Form Dress Code

At The Emmbrook School, Sixth Form students are expected to dress in a **smart casual manner that is suitable for a school setting**. While we recognise students' growing independence and individuality, it is important that attire reflects the standards of a professional learning environment.

General Guidelines

- Students may wear casual clothing, but it must be suitable for a school setting.
- Clothing that is overly revealing, includes offensive slogans or imagery, or is otherwise deemed inappropriate is not permitted.
- **Hoods, and hats** must not be worn inside the school buildings.
- **Flip flops, sliders and crocs** must not be worn due to health and safety factors.

Occasional Formal Wear

- On certain occasions, such as supporting school events or representing the Sixth Form, students may be asked to wear more formal attire.

Identification

- It is **compulsory** for all Sixth Form students to wear their **photo ID lanyards at all times** while on site.

Final Decision

- Where a student's dress is deemed inappropriate for the school environment, they may be asked to leave the site and return once dressed suitably.
- The **Head of Sixth Form** and/or **Assistant Headteacher for Key Stage 5** will have the **final say** in all matters relating to the interpretation and enforcement of the dress code.
