Year 13 Exams – Tuesday 5th January – Tuesday 12th January

Dear Parents and Carers,

As you are aware from my previous communication, the next round of year 13 exams are taking place from Tuesday 5th January until Tuesday 12th January. All A-level subjects, with the exception of criminology, will be undertaking at least one paper during this period. Criminology students will be undertaking their formal controlled assessment in January.

The exam timetable will be given out to students in form time, and I would encourage you to discuss this with your child so that, as parents you have an overview of the exam timetable as well.

In addition, all year 13 students will be on **study leave** for this exam period and lessons will restart on **Wednesday 13th January**.

As I stated previously, this round of exams will provide everyone involved in the A-level journey with a valuable insight into the progress the students are making towards the A-level exam season in June. Based on the outcomes of the January examinations, the A-level tutor team will be working with students, curriculum areas, and parents to put in place action plans for the students. These action plans will focus on supporting the students in making the final steps necessary to achieve in June.

The results from these examinations, and the subsequent actions put in place, will also inform the discussions you have with teachers at our next year 13 parents' consultation evening on **Wednesday 16th March**.
