## **Headteacher's Weekly Update**

### **National Strike Action by the NEU**

Wednesday saw the first day of strike action by members of the NEU. Three additional dates have been announced for March:

- Thursday 2<sup>nd</sup> March
- Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> March
- Thursday 16<sup>th</sup> March

I am very grateful to parents who supported their children to attend the online lessons. Years 11-13 managed the day here on site well.

The number of our staff who took strike action on Wednesday was sufficient that it would not have been possible to operate a normal school day; it would have been very challenging to have more students on site. This experience will necessarily inform our response to future strikes. With summer exams now only a few months away Years 11 and 13 will have to remain priority year groups and I hope that all parents can understand that. I will communicate plans for the next strike on Friday 24<sup>th</sup> February.

#### **Year 11 Wave & Non-core Exams**

The first two weeks after half-term will see Year 11 students sitting the final round of preparatory exams before the real ones start in May. On Friday, all students will have an extended form period and Year 11 will focus on getting the most out of half-term. Please support your child to use the time wisely, good tips include:

- Help them to create and stick to a revision timetable.
- Encourage a quiet work space free from distractions.
- Suggest that they use a variety of methods (e.g. flash cards, notes, posters, online activities/videos, mind maps, exam questions)
- Utilise the online resources that we use (e.g. Maths Watch, Tassomai, Seneca)
- Encourage them to work in short bursts (30 minutes), with breaks.
- Keep them active, in a good sleep routine and doing fun things too!
- Help them to keep things in perspective stress doesn't aid preparation.
