Peer mentoring	One to one support of Year7 or 8 pupils. Volunteers must also attend a 1 day training session and supervision meetings once every half term.

All students will be expected to choose 1 or 2 of these.

*there is also the option of becoming a dept 'ambassador' and helping out in that specific dept. Ambassadors will go above and beyond the 'helping out in class' role currently completed for community service. Ambassadors will be present at open evenings and offer advice and guidance to exam classes based on their own experiences.

**students could also offer community service outside of the school – primary schools, local charities etc – these would be arranged on an individual basis. There must be some tangible reason for the external posting. All outside postings must conform to child protection procedure.
