



## Sixth Form Uniform Policy

This uniform policy has been updated. It is designed to strike a balance between what students perceive as comfortable and what the school deems acceptable as formal 'work' wear.

Students are expected to conform to the uniform policy. Any student who does not conform will be turned away from school, attendance data marked accordingly and could impact on future references.

Sandals are OK as some female teachers wear sandals (unless in a workshop environment)

Piercings must be discreet.

### Girls

#### Tops:

- Shoulders covered
- No logos
- No mid-riff showing/no crop tops
- No hoodies
- No denim of any colour
- No denim jackets or jeans

#### Skirts/Trousers:

- Girls must wear skirts of appropriate length, smart trousers, chinos, shorts of appropriate length (with black/navy/grey tights if above the knee)
- Linen trousers in summer conditions
- Dresses of appropriate length are allowed
- Leggings can only be worn as a replacement for tights (under skirts, dresses or shorts)
- No skinny jeans of any colour

#### Shoes:

- Smart work shoes
- No trainers of any kind
- Heels of appropriate size (maximum 1 inch)
- No flip flops

### Boys

#### Tops:

- Tops worn to always have a collar - Shirts and polo shirts
- Tie (optional)
- Shoulders covered
- No logos
- No hoodies

#### Trousers:

- Chinos or suit trousers
- Linen trousers in summer conditions
- No denim of any colour
- No denim jackets or jeans
- No shorts
- No skinny jeans of any colour

#### Shoes:

- Smart work shoes
- No trainers of any kind
- No flip flops

All piercings must be discreet

All tattoos must be covered
