To ensure that all staff are actively contributing to the success of HPP. Our target To improve attendance for HPP.

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

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#### T1.1 Update

HPP feedback to milestone tasks must be of the highest quality Every teacher must have a seating plan highlighting where HPP are sitting

Teachers should carefully seat HPP so that they are sat with an appropriately motivated student.

HPP are always

prioritised

TAs must know who the HPP are in any given class and support appropriately

When teachers are questioning their class

All departments should have an action plan for HPP underperforming in their subject area

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## OUR PUPIL PREMIUM PLEDGE

The performance of HPP must be raised at every departmental meeting and must be the first agenda item

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A champion should be nominated in each department who will raise any concerns over academic performance for HPP

Every Curriculum Line manager meeting must have a section on the performance HPP and details of actions that are being undertaken to improve academic outcomes.

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HPP should be the first in their year group to receive a careers interview.

Homework completion rates for HPP will be monitored and support will be provided to students who regularly fail to complete homework to a suitable standard.

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HPP will receive additional rewards/incentives for attending school on a regular basis.

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## OUR PUPIL PREMIUM PLEDGE

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HPP who fail to attend school regularly will be prioritised through their attendance action plan HPP who fail to engage with school effectively will be prioritised through their pastoral support plan

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HPP will be approached to join extra-curricular activities and this will be monitored HPP will receive a learning pack which ensure that they have the correct equipment for every lesson
