



National Plan for Music Education – The Emmbrook Music Department School Actions 2024-25

Leadership and Management

1. To discuss the Emmbrook Music Dept's NPME actions in each category with SLT, and discuss the place of Music as a specific subject within the School Improvement Plan, alongside the Music Development Plan.
2. To establish links with other Music departments/Music co-ordinators in other schools within the Circle Trust.

Curriculum

1. To strengthen the Emmbrook's singing strategy both within the curriculum and within extra-curricular provision to build on the solid foundations that are already in place.
2. To improve the range of specialist equipment/instruments and spaces available for successful music teaching and music making to take place in line with the curricular KS3 vision.

Extra-curricular and Instrumental Provision

1. To establish opportunities for our talented musicians to develop their leadership skills through a range of musical events/activities.
2. To create more opportunities for Emmbrook students to gain performing experience in a range of informal settings, to encourage greater numbers of students to engage in a broader range of musical performance/composition, thereby providing increased enrichment and confidence-building.
3. To more strongly track and monitor students' engagement in musical enrichment activities, both in and out of school – and regularly 'celebrate' such commitment and personal musical successes.



Community and Partnership

1. To continue to strengthen links with the Berkshire Music Trust, and to build other musical partnerships to provide a wider range of musical enrichment for Emmbrook students.
2. One particular area for development will be to strengthen our links with those working in the Music Industry, and raising students' awareness of the range of careers within the Music Industry as a whole.
